


Bidder's Query	JVNL Response
1. In the PQR condition points no 1) The Bidder must be a single bidder. Can this be amended for allowing a consortium or Joint venture?	No. The bidder must be a single bidder.
2. Section IV Detailed scope, 2.1 (f) The ATP collection centers are primarily for deposition of electricity bills. However, JVNL may use these counters for extending other services like providing duplicate bills, new connection & other request forms, etc through these counters. No extra payment shall be made against such use. The ATP machine specification asks for only a receipt printer, only the matter that can be printed on the receipt printer can be printed.	ATP machine shall have an inbuilt printer which will be able to print image of the cheque on the receipt in case of a payment through cheque. However, JVNL may use these centers for distributing various pre printed application forms, information to public. This shall not require any alteration in the specifications of ATP machine.
3. Section IV Detailed scope, 2.1 (g) Retired army/police personnel may be deputed as security guard on all high volume ATP collection centers. Is it mandatory to provide only these cater/type of people?	This is only a recommendation. However, the security of the ATP center being the responsibility of the bidder, the bidder may deploy any reliable security guard of his choice.
4. In case any new subdivision, division or circle is created subsequently during the currency of contract, ATP ATP collection centers shall be created as well and manpower shall also be deployed there. Adequate persons at each ATP ATP collection center shall be deployed without any extra cost to Discom.	In case any new subdivision is created or added within the circle under the bidder's scope, one ATP machine per subdivision shall have to be installed at the designated collection center of the newly created sub division, subject to limit of maximum 10% additional ATP machines of the total number as per the contract. <p>5. Page 39 Transaction Charges; It is stated that 5% will be paid after the submissions of Annual reports. This is a considerable amount and the very nature of the work requires daily settlement and daily reports and all the reports specified are daily reports. Request for amendment.</p>	<p>No amendment required.</p>
<p>6. Page No 60, DISHONoured cheques are usually sent to account holder, how can the responsibility of accounting and reconciliation of the same be on the bidder's scope.</p>	<p>The agency shall be responsible for collection of dishonoured cheques from bank and hand over the same to the respective office.</p>
<p>7. The variation in labour component and the respective formula for arriving at the same is 92. But there is not scope to quote for bifurcation of charges as per the bid document.</p>	<p>It is clear from the formula of price variation that the labour portion has been fixed at 50% of the price.</p>
<p>8. Original bank solvency/credit worthiness certificate from any schedule bank for execution of Rs. 3 cr. Can this be provided by the successful bidder post tender, as it is mentioned to be provided along with the tender document?</p>	<p>Yes, the bidder can submit undertaking of providing the bank solvency/credit worthiness certificate post tender, if stands successful.</p>
<p>9. Can the EMD amount of Rs. 7,00,000 be submitted vide bank guarantee.</p>	<p>Refer to corrigendum issued on 20/11/2012.</p>

<p>10. The schedule of prices indicated are Telescopic, a non-telescopic rate schedule would benefit the DISCOM.</p>	<p>There is no change in the price structure.</p>
<p>11. Liquidate Damages and penalty:</p> <p>a. Can you explain the INCORRECT COLLECTION, if a consumer operates and does the transaction then who will be responsible? Can this be defined in detail.</p> <p>b. Delay in opening and early closing is it is not totally under the hands of the bidder (There might be a strike, local conditions etc., where on a particular day it might not be possible) this needs to be exempted. The penalty amount is high for low transaction counters.</p> <p>c. Connectivity is not in the hands in the service provider and we have to depend on the service provider and no service provider is will to provide connectivity with a penal condition.</p>	<p>'Incorrect collection' can be termed to many situations in which the amount remitted to the JVVNL's bank account is different from what the consumer has deposited.</p> <p>No change in the condition.</p> <p>No change in the condition.</p>


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
